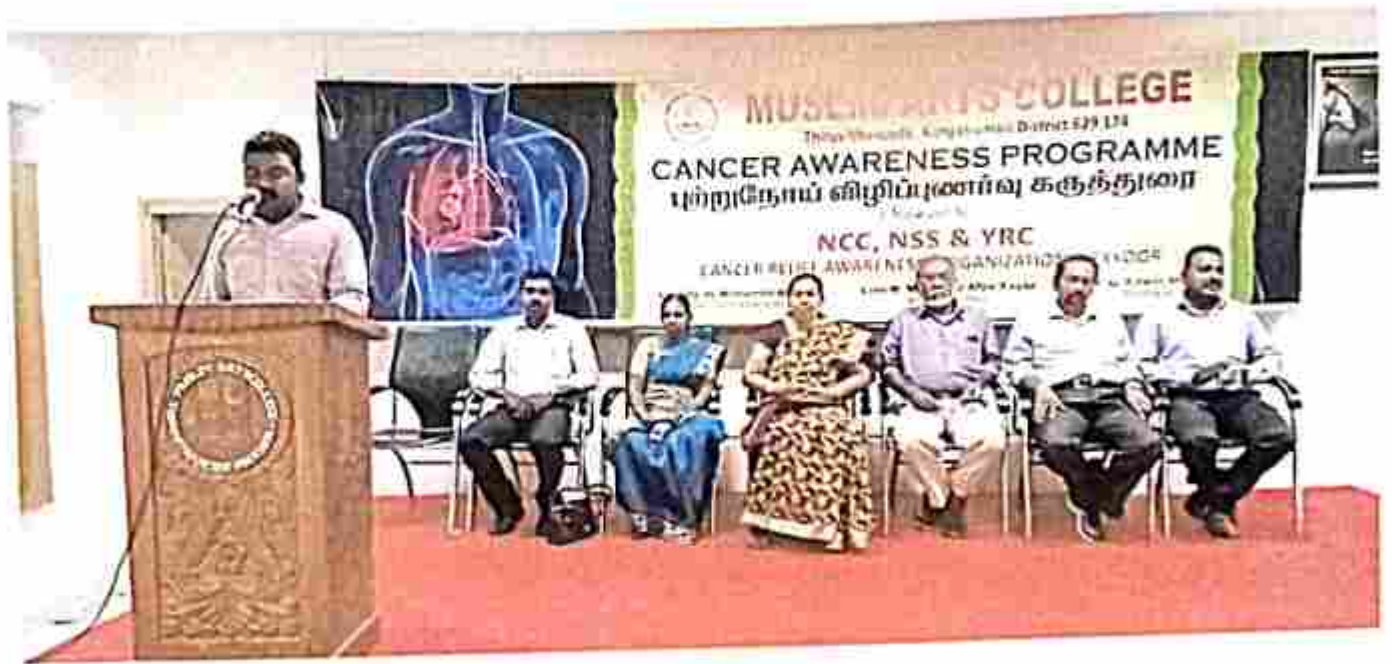

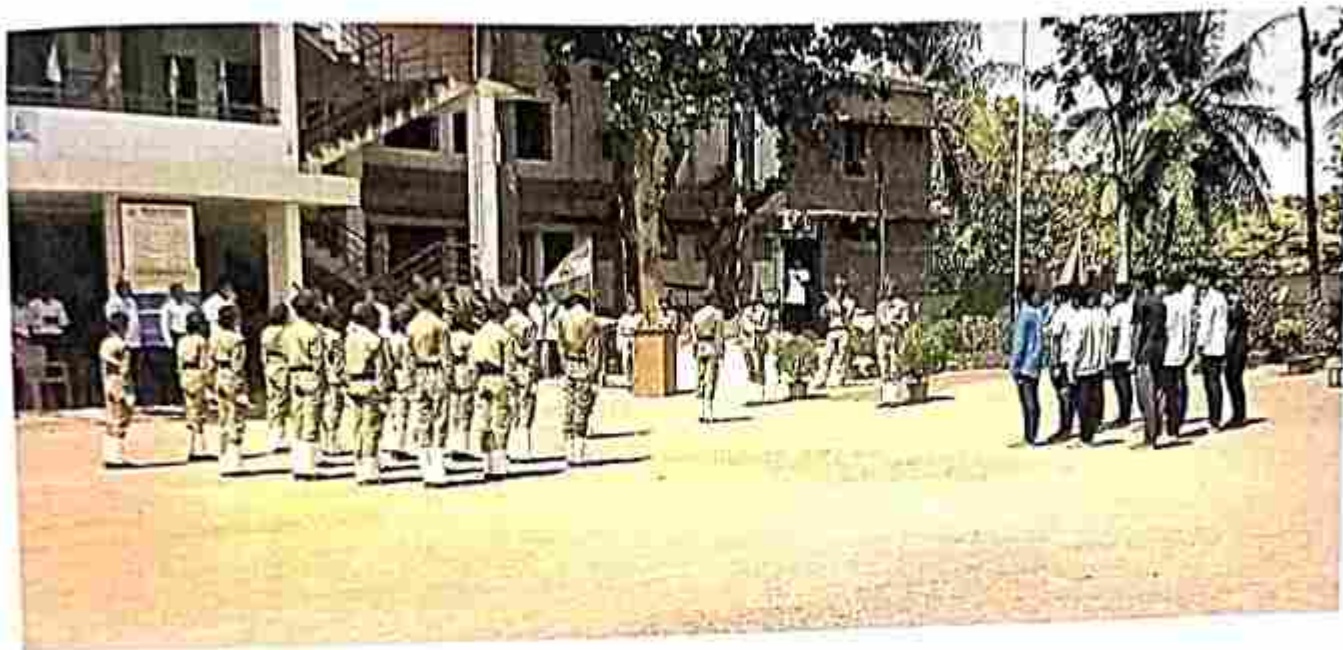


On this day every cadets fallin at 8:00 AM. After that cadets were room-up to loose themselves. After that SMO reported SMO.

As the part of this cleaning programme, we cleaned the some of the places surrounding the court.

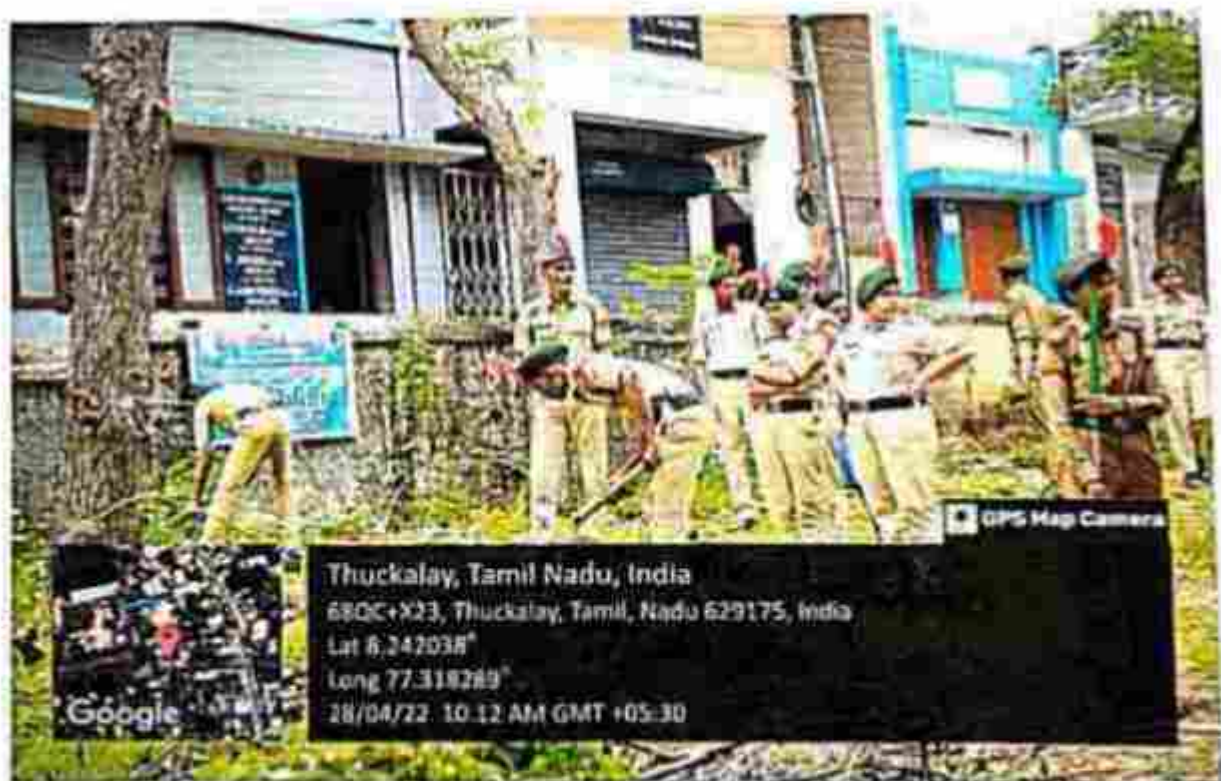
